Somewhere in France

Dear Editor and Friends:

"If I may have a bit of space, I would like to tell you a bit about France and the boys over here. France is really and truly a very beautiful and thriving country. I have covered hundreds of miles through France and have seen some very interesting and exciting sights as well as some not so good. Back in Normandy, I landed at Utah Beach, and the quiet comfortable days and night there were not to be found. Artillery fire seemed to never cease. As we moved along, seeing dead everywhere and destruction of all kinds, well, it made us appreciate home as we had never before, however we soon got used to it and it did not affect us as it did. Some of the going was tough, sometimes we would go like wildfire. Part of the time the Germans retreated so fast we could hardly keep up with them, but now the going is pretty tough, as it was in the beginning.

"I am in an M.P. Combat outfit and we perhaps see as much as anyone, as we keep on the move constantly. I was recently on a post all alone during the wee hours of a moonlit night. A German dive bomber swooped down at tree top level over my head, but, by the help of God, he never released a bomb nor tried to strafe me. However about a thousand yards away, he strafed at two of my buddies, but missed them.

"We would all like to be at home, but we have a victory to win and we

en want to stay until it is over. At Germany's defeat, we wonder if we go home, remain in an army of occupation, or go to the Pacific. As there are about three million soldiers still in the States, we all feel as if we would be glad to put up the rest of our time there and let them see what they can do to lick the Japs. We are not griping because we had to leave our immediate families and friends, sleep in the mud and rain, where danger was imminent, but we have so far, and will continue, to do a good job, but when it's over over here, we all want to come back when transportation is available. Despite the fact that France has been under Nazi control for four years, it is surprising to see many available articles here that are scarce in the States. I have seen lots of England and Scotland, but, I and I think all of the others prefer France to Great Britain.



WEATHER WISDOM

Mountain Time—All territory between the last named line and nearly the west borders of Idaho, Utah and Arizona.

Pacific Time—All territory between the last named and the Pacific Ocean.

The time of each section differs from that next to it by exactly one hour, thus at 12 o'clock noon, New York (Eastern Time), it is 11 A.M. at Chicago (Central Time), 10 A.M. at Denver (Mountain Time), and 9 A.M. at San Francisco (Pacific Time).
